



REGISTRATION CONDITIONS

Those registered with a library that is a member of the RERO Network are already registered by default with all partner libraries and may borrow documents from the IOC Library without any additional formality.

Those aged 14 and over who belong to one of the following categories may register with the Library free of charge:

People resident in Switzerland

Documents to be presented:

- a valid Swiss ID card, or
- a valid Swiss passport, or
- a valid residence permit in categories B, C, F, L or N. B, F and N permits must be valid for a minimum of three months after the date of registering with the library; the L permit must be valid for a minimum of three months after the date of registering with the library and accompanied with a course/internship certificate on letter-headed paper, or
- a card from a partner library of another Swiss network (e.g. IDS).

Swiss citizens living abroad

Documents to be presented:

- a valid Swiss ID card, or
- a valid Swiss passport as well as a reference address or a certificate of secondary residence in Switzerland.

People living near the border who work in the canton of Vaud

Documents to be presented:

- a border authorisation valid for a minimum of three months after the date of registering with the library and a certificate of residence or from the employer on letter-headed paper.

Those aged under 14 who wish to borrow documents must do so through the intermediary of their legal guardian.

For other cases, a provisional card, which is valid only for the IOC Library, may be obtained.
